ADORATION of the Most Blessed Sacrament

Let us pray

(Pause)

Most merciful Father and in the sacred heart of your son, wounded by our sins, You have blessed us with your infinite love. Let us revere in You, and let us seek repentance for our sins, in Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

PRAYER: In front of the Most Blessed Sacrament:

Lord Jesus Christ, because of your divine love for us, You make known of your presence in the Blessed Sacrament, full of divine mercy and love.

Now I come to adore you.

I come to thank you for your boundless Love and Divine Mercy;
I come to ask for your forgiveness for my frequent lack of faith,
which has greatly offended You.

May You help me to see your presence through my eyes of faith, to love you through loving the least of my brothers, and to open my heart in the silence of my soul to seek you out and to listen to your will for my life.

And I also ask for your divine mercy for the deliverance of souls in purgatory, especially for the souls of the faithful, who had loved and served the Blessed Sacrament and for the souls of our departed love ones. We ask for the prayers and intercessions of our Blessed Virgin Mary. *Amen.*

Let us pray,

Most merciful Father, You continue to draw us to Yourself through the Eucharistic Mystery. Grant us fervent faith in this Sacrament of Love, in which Christ the Lord Himself is contained, offered and received. We make this prayer through the same Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

BENEDICTION
Adoration/Procession of the Blessed Sacrament

After adoration/(procession, Celebrant returns to Sanctuary and place the Monstrance - **Blessed Sacrament** on the Altar, facing the congregation. *Then the Celebrant comes down and kneels in front of Altar Facing the exposed **Blessed Sacrament** and) Lead the following prayer:*

(Congregation repeat after the priest)

Blessed be Jesus Christ, true God and true man.
Blessed be the Name of Jesus.
Blessed be His Most Sacred Heart.
Blessed be His Most Previous Blood.
Blessed be Jesus in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar.
Blessed be the Holy Spirit the Paraclete.
Blessed be the great Mother of God, Mary Most Holy.
Blessed be her Holy and Immaculate Conception.
Blessed be her Glorious Assumption.
Blessed be the name of Mary, Virgin and Mother.
Blessed be St. Joseph, her most chaste spouse.
Blessed be God in His Angels and His Saints.

Lord Jesus Christ,

FINAL BLESSING *(All Kneel)*

The priest(s) returns to sanctuary after the prayer:

The priest puts on the humeral veil, genuflects and takes the monstrance or ciborium. He makes the Sign of the Cross over the people with the monstrance or ciborium, in silence.
